## SALVATION ARMY RED KETTLE VOLUNTEERS INFORMATION

### MERRY CHRISTMAS WOODLAND HEIGHTS,

It's that time of year again and I would like to invite you to participate in the Salvation Army's Red Kettle Collection for Montgomery County!

You can work alone or make it a family service project or grab a friend or family member and ring the bell for Montgomery County. Your time and effort will generate much needed funds to help Montgomery County folks; and not to mention spread Christmas cheer.

Here are some "guidelines" that should answer most of your questions about ringing. Please don't hesitate to call if you have any other questions.

### RINGING GUIDELINES

- Please arrive 10 minutes before you're scheduled to begin.
- If you are the first shift of the day the Red Kettle, Two Aprons and Bell will be stored inside the door. You may have to search a little.
- Set up out of people traffic. Both stores we are working will allow you to be inside. People who want to give will seek you out.
- The Salvation Army boldly proclaims Christ at Christmas time!! Feel free to say Merry Christmas and Thank you!
- If you are the last shift someone from the Salvation Army will arrive at 7pm to collect the contents of the Kettle. If the Salvation Army representative is late, put the Kettle inside and put the aprons over it. You are not expected to stay past 7 pm. Don't take the kettle home :o) I guess that has happened.
- If no one arrives to relieve you please call the number provided on the Red Kettle or me at the number below (unless you are the last shift).
- If you are unable to serve at the time you chose please find a replacement by trading with someone else on the schedule. WHCC is responsible for every time slot on the schedule. If you cannot find someone to take your place contact me at the number below.
